



Adding Beta and Preliminary Fixture Profiles to wysiwyg

The fixture(s) provided here has/have not yet been tested by CAST Software. Beta and Preliminary fixture profiles are built using specifications and tests conducted by users on behalf of CAST Software. They are distributed in this manner in order to satisfy urgent customer needs and no warranty of their accuracy is made, though we do believe they are reasonably accurate simulations. If you experience any problems whatsoever with these fixture profiles, please inform libraries@cast-soft.com as soon as possible.

Important Notes:

- ✓ These files are in **R49/2023** format **and may not work in earlier versions of the software**. Installation must be performed under a login account with administrative privileges.
- ✓ These files will be updated based on user feedback and once testing has been completed.
- ✓ No data layouts are included, so plot attributes will need to be set up by users.
- ✓ To share wysiwyg files containing these fixture profiles, all other users must also add these files into their library.
- ✓ If you need to contact technical support, for whatever reason, please inform them that you are using these Beta/Preliminary fixture profiles. Additionally, please inform all users who are sharing these files of this requirement.
- ✓ These files may be included in a future version of wysiwyg. These files should be added to the Library folder after every installation, until the fixture(s) have been included in a new version—please consult each version's Release Notes to find out if this was done.

To add these files to the wysiwyg library:

1. Ensure that wysiwyg is not running.
2. Save the attached .zip file to your hard drive.
3. Unzip the contents of this file *into* the Library folder—**DO NOT place the .zip file itself into this folder!** (The default location for this folder is [C:\Program Files\CAST Software\WYSIWYG Release XX\Library](#) where XX is the Release number) **Should you be asked about replacing existing files, ensure that you allow this.**
4. Run wysiwyg R49/2023, and open either a new or existing file: a message appears stating that the library index is being rebuilt – this is normal; the file will open once the index rebuild is complete.
